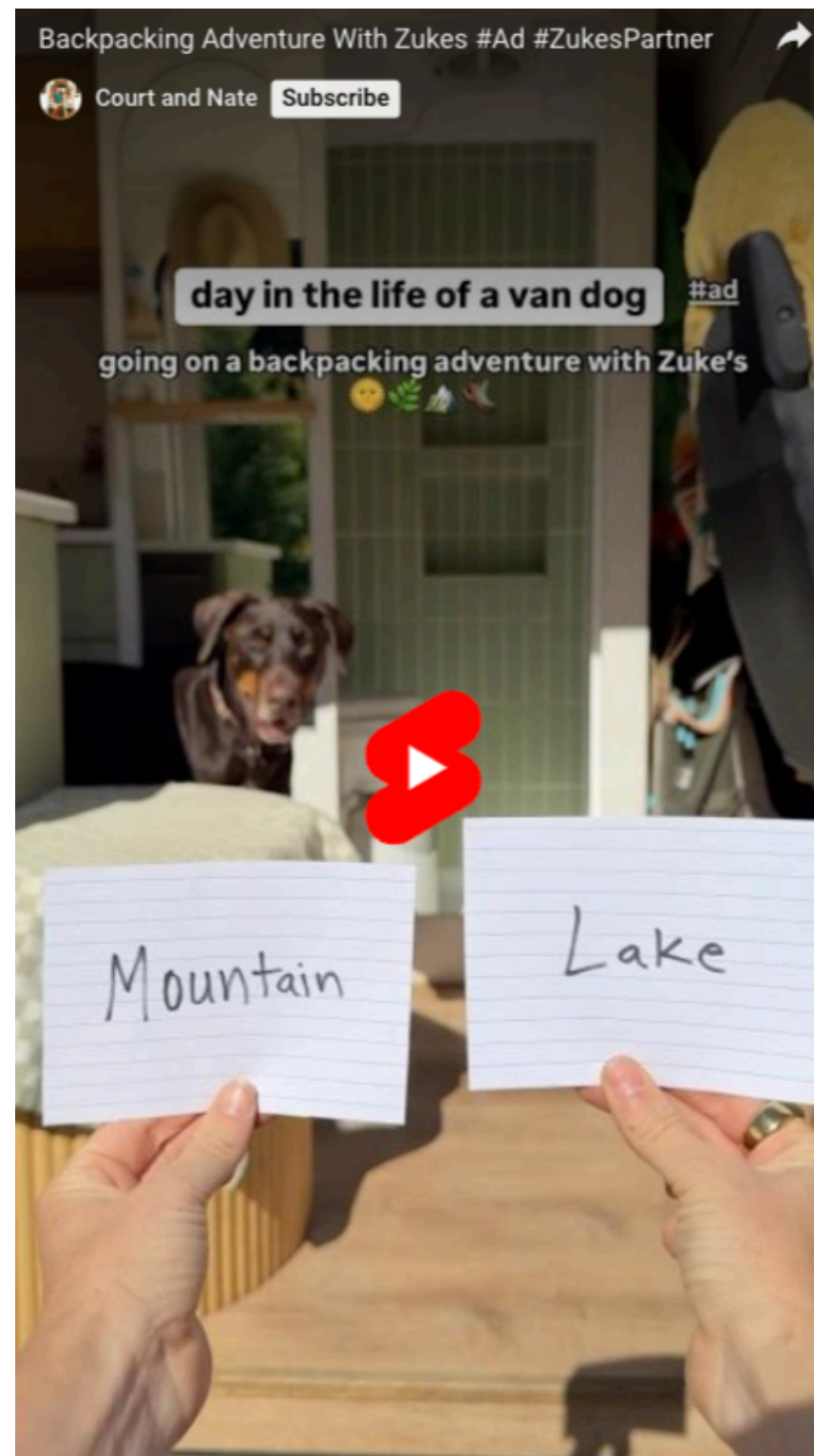

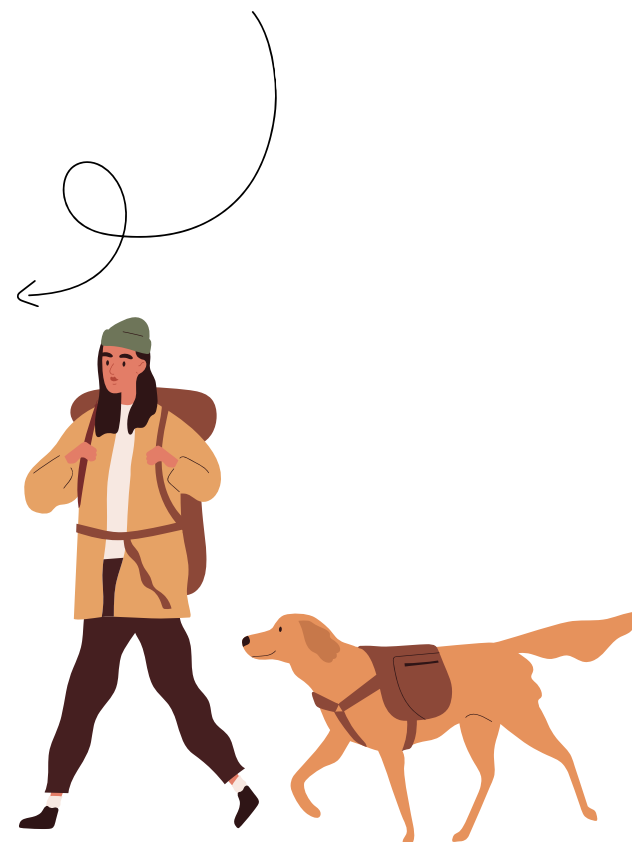
**van - a medium-sized vehicle with windows all round, used for carrying more people than an ordinary car*

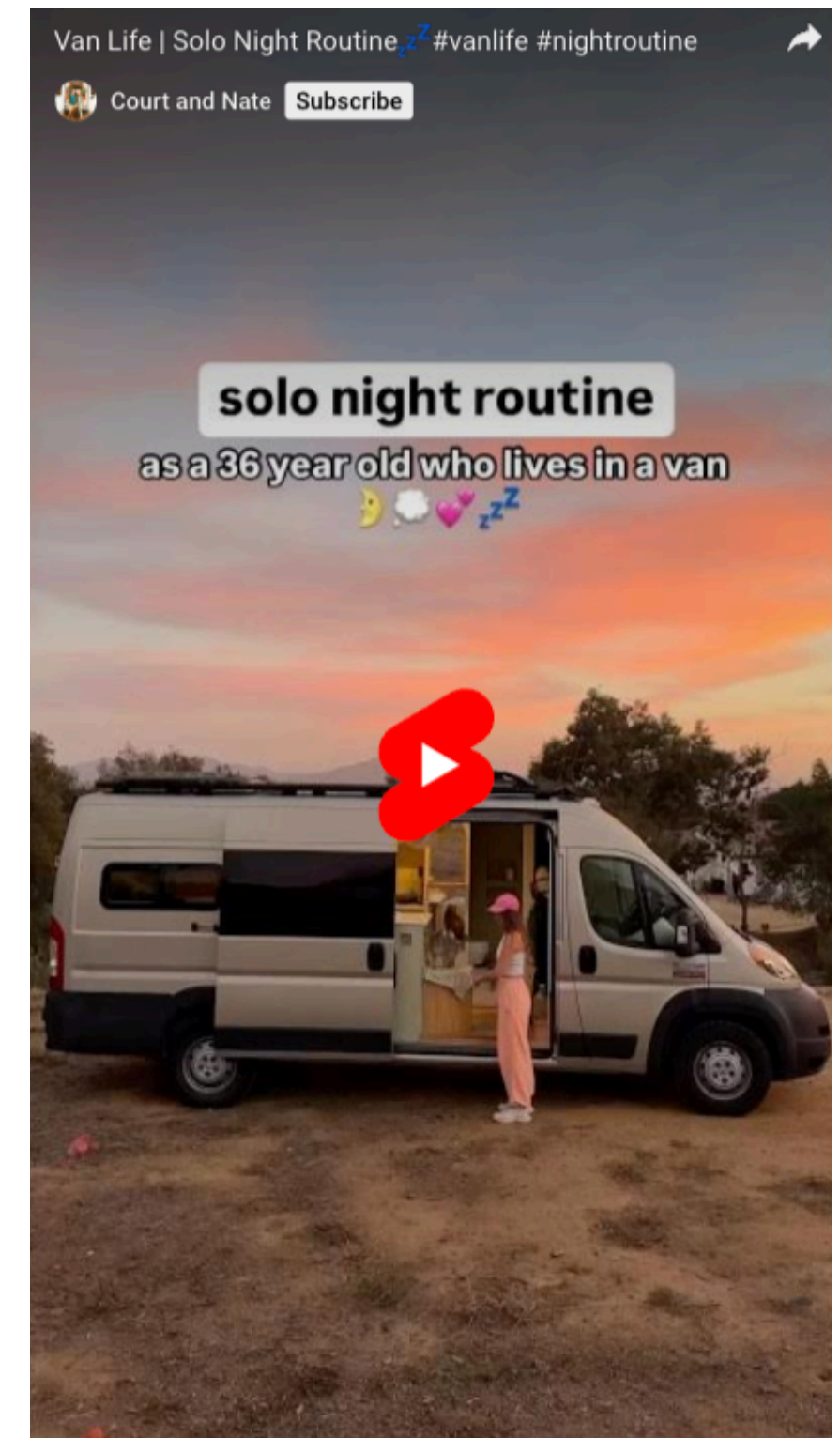

Present simple and present continuous

Read the rule and **choose** the correct option.

- Use the present *simple/continuous* to talk about facts, things which are generally true or something that happens regularly.

Every day, we wake up early, I make coffee and my boyfriend walks the dog.

- Use the present *simple/continuous* to describe something happening now.

The sun is shining, and the birds are singing.

- You can also use the present continuous to describe a *permanent/temporary* situation happening around now.

I am currently experimenting with new ways to store our clothes.

- We use the present *simple/continuous* with stative verbs.

My boyfriend is checking the van because we need to fix the engine.

- It is common to use time expressions like *at the moment, right now* and *these days* with the present *simple/continuous*.

Right now, I am sitting outside and drinking my coffee.

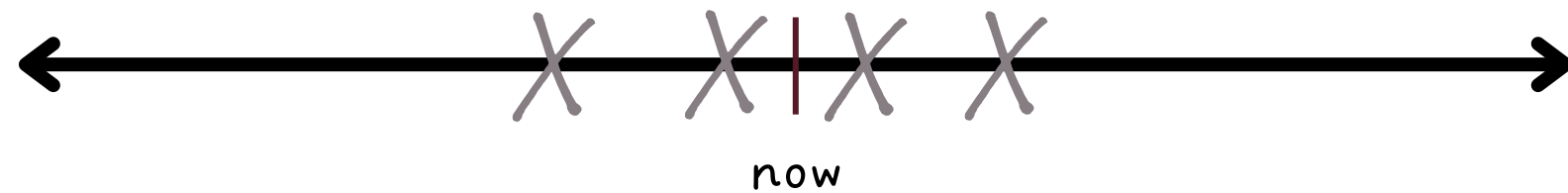
- It is common to use time expressions like *usually, sometimes, always, never, often, seldom, rarely, on Mondays, every day...* with the present *simple/continuous*.

Every day, we wake up early, I make coffee and my boyfriend walks the dog.

PRESENT SIMPLE VS PRESENT CONTINUOUS

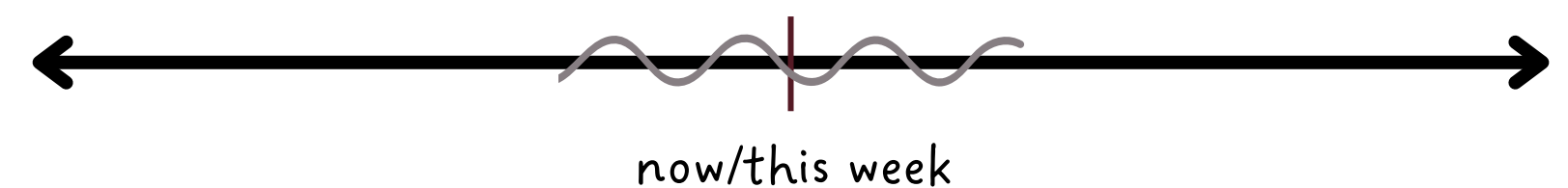
present simple

I **live** in a van with my boyfriend, our cat, and our dog.



present continuous

Right now, I **am sitting** outside and drinking my coffee.



- Things which are always true, facts. *The sun rises in the morning.*
- Habits or things we do regularly. *Every day, we wake up early, I make coffee and my boyfriend walks the dog.*
- We use the present simple and not continuous with **stative verbs**: be, want, cost, need, belong, like, love, hate, dislike, fear, know etc. *My boyfriend is checking the van because we need to fix the engine.*

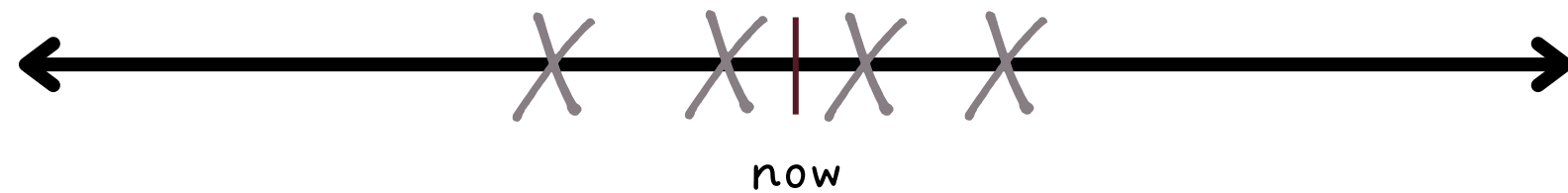


- Things which are happening at the moment of speaking. *The sun is shining, and the birds are singing.*
- Temporary situations. *This month, we are working on organising the van better.*
- Temporary or new habits. *I am currently experimenting with new ways to store our clothes.*

PRESENT SIMPLE VS PRESENT CONTINUOUS

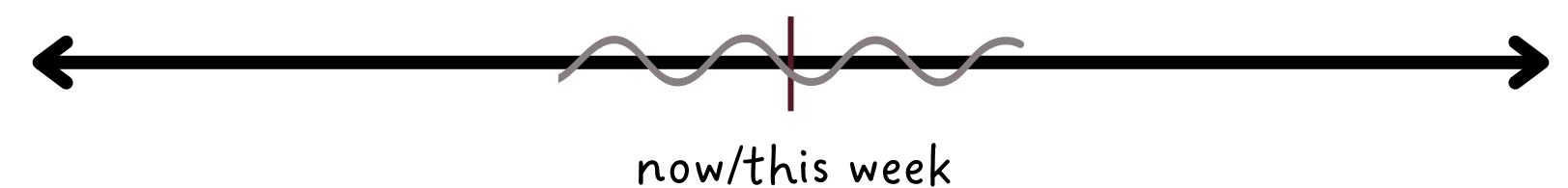
present simple

present continuous

Right now, I **am sitting** outside and drinking my coffee.

rarely, on Mondays, every day, in the mornings etc.

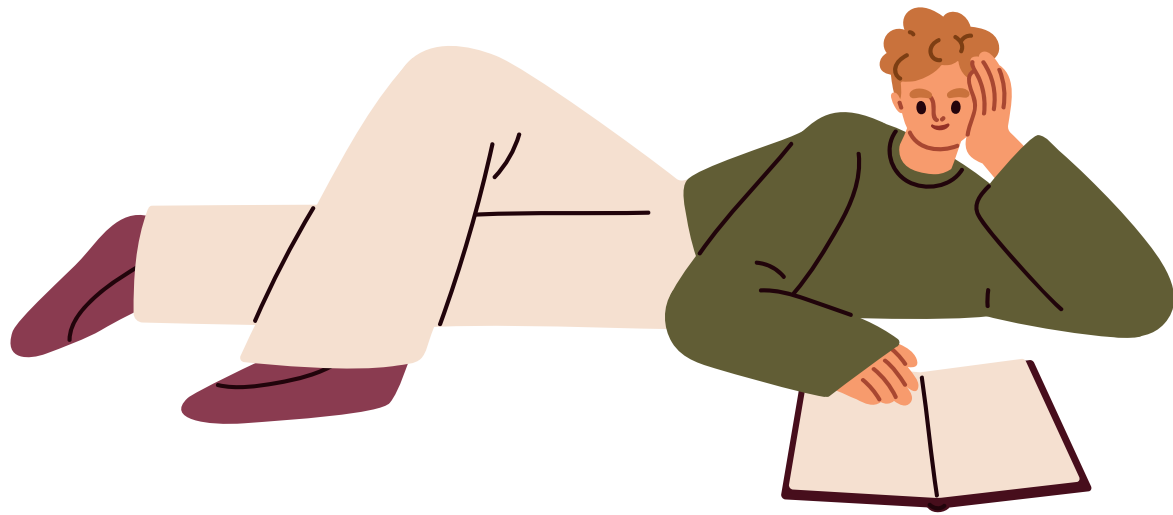

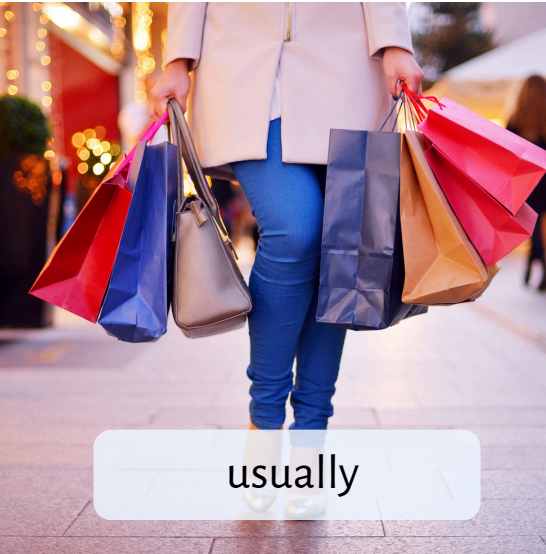

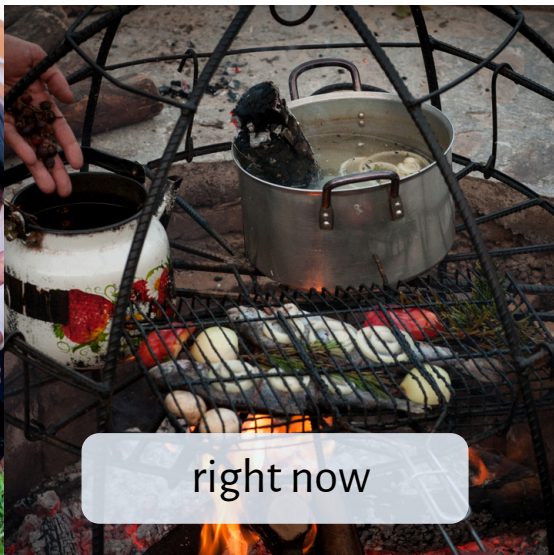

ROLE-PLAY

- Ask follow-up questions to keep the conversation going.
